

# Welcome to Hollywood Beach

The following Rules and Regulations are in place for your safety and enjoyment:



## Swimming permitted

Except in designated vessel launching areas. "Diver Down" flag required beyond 150 feet.

## Casual beach games & kite flying permitted

No object is to be used which might reasonably endanger anyone.

## Snorkeling or scuba diving permitted

"Diver Down" flag required. Spear fishing prohibited within 300 ft of the beach. Loaded spear gun prohibited on public beach or in public swimming areas. Fish bag and raft required to transport speared fish through swimming areas.

## Surfing allowed in designated areas only

Surfing allowed only between Georgia Street and Azalea Terrace, and between Meade and Franklin Street. Beach Safety Supervisor has the authority to allow surfing in other areas as conditions warrant; look for the black flag designating open areas. Ankle leashes required as a safety precaution.

## Surf fishing allowed, restrictions apply

Surf fishing allowed immediately north of the Dania fishing pier at all times. The remainder of the beach allows surf fishing from 6 p.m. to 8 a.m. only. Fishing also allowed from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. in areas north of Sherman Street and south of Georgia Street if a minimum 200 yards distance from bathers is maintained. Bathers have priority on beach use. Beach safety personnel may open additional areas and extend restricted hours to fishing due to bather load/capacity, weather or other conditions.

## Use of inflatable rafts, inner tubes, flotation devices permitted

Flotation devices are prohibited during severe water or weather conditions. Flotation devices limited to accommodate no more than two people.

## Volleyball permitted at designated locations

Locations limited to courts and nets installed or approved in writing by the City of Hollywood.



## Launching of non-motorized vessels permitted in designated areas

Non-motorized vessels permitted between Meade Street and Custer Street and between Bougainvillea Terrace and Azalea Terrace. **Non-motorized** vessels include kayaks, rowboats, canoes, recreational wind-powered watercraft and any non-motorized watercraft which use human physical effort as their primary source of motive power. Launching of motorized vessels and personal watercraft by the public is prohibited.



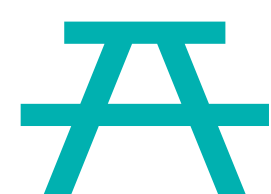
## Bicycling on the Broadwalk permitted within designated bike path

Bicyclists must operate their bicycles in a safe manner, at a moderate speed and maintain control. **Pedestrians are not to walk in the bike lane.**



## Roller skating and rollerblading permitted on the Broadwalk

If you roller skate or rollerblade in an unsafe or reckless manner you may be subject to ejection from the beach and Broadwalk. **Skateboards are prohibited on the Broadwalk.**



## Picnicking allowed in designated areas only

Picnicking permitted only on the sandy beach between Sherman Street and Custer Street, in Charnow, Keating and Harry Berry Parks and on the Broadwalk between Jefferson Street and Simms Street. Picnicking prohibited in all other areas.



## Pets are not permitted on the beach or Broadwalk.



## The open consumption of alcoholic beverages and glass containers are prohibited on the beach and Broadwalk.

The Division of Beach Safety, Police Department and other enforcement personnel have the authority to approve, limit or prohibit activities on the municipal beach due to the intensity of the activity, crowd levels, weather or other conditions which warrant such limitation or prohibition.
